Dream Chaser by **Kristen Ashley** (Mass Market Paperback – \$18). *Dream Team Series*. Ryn Jansen has no interest in taking a risk on Boone Sadler. Thanks to a long list of men who've done nothing but let her down, Ryn vows to stay far away from the caring, protective commando. And when Boone confronts Ryn with evidence that her loved ones are conning her, Ryn is less than thrilled – with her family and Boone. But even as Boone proves he's the kind of guy to meet her every need, she doesn't trust him to stay when life gets hard ... Boone Sadler's never been one to back down from a challenge. He's determined to show the funny, sexy Ryn that the irresistible connection between them is worth exploring. But caring for Ryn's heart and body becomes a matter of life and death when Ryn's beloved niece and nephew are put in danger and dirty cops begin gunning for Ryn. Soon Boone realizes their romance is in danger of more than heartbreak – and to have any future together, they'll have to put their trust in each other.

Together they are at the heart of the ticking-clock investigation into a psychopathic murderer ... Detective Kara Quinn is on an early morning jog in Liberty Lake when she discovers the body of a young nurse. The manner of death reveals a highly controlled rage ... Word quickly reaches FBI special agent Matt Costa that this murder fits the profile of the elusive Triple Killer, who compulsively strikes every three years, targeting three victims, each three days apart. This time they have a chance to stop him. But only if they can decipher the meaning of his pattern to figure out who he is and where he is hiding before he strikes again ... The stakes have never been higher, because if they fail, one of their own team may be next.

Special Ops Seduction by **Megan Crane** (Mass Market Paperback – \$18). *Alaska Force Series*. After an official operation turned deadly, Jonas Crow began a new life in Grizzly Harbor with Alaska Force. But when fellow soldier Bethan Wilcox joins the group, she forces him to remember things he actively prefers to forget. That's unforgivable enough. But now the two of them are forced together on a mission to uncover deadly secrets tied to their complicated past, and with the heat between them at a boil, forgiveness is the least of his worries ... Bethan Wilcox, one of the first women to make it through Army Ranger school, didn't join Alaska Force to deal with Jonas's foul temper. Or her own errant attraction to him. Thrown together in a race against the clock, they have to pretend to be a couple and play nice to throw the enemy off their scent. She knows better than to let their pretend love feel real ... especially while time is running out ... Jonas has always been good at saving the world. But it's Bethan he needs to save this time around – if she doesn't save him first.

Truths, Lies and Second Dates by **MaryJanice Davidson** (Trade Paperback – \$32). Captain Ava Capp has been flying from her past for a decade. She'd much rather leave it, and her home state,

behind forever. But when she finds herself back in Minnesota, against her better judgment, everything goes sideways in a way she never expected it to ... M.E. Dr. Tom Baker has never forgotten Ava and the cold case she ran away from. When she shows up unexpectedly in town, in spite of himself, sparks fly. Which is terrible because he can't stop his growing attraction to her. Can these two Type-A's let their guards down and work together to put Ava's tragic past behind her for good? And keep their hands off each other at the same time?

Met Her Match by **Jude Deveraux** (Mass Market Paperback Release – \$20). *Summerhouse Series*. Terri Rayburn is a girl with a reputation. She doesn't deserve it, but having grown up on the outskirts of Summer Hill, Virginia, she knows how small towns work. The only way to deal with vicious gossip is to ignore it. So she keeps to herself as she runs the summer resort on Lake Kissel ... When she returns home from a short trip to find a handsome stranger living in her house, she smells a rat. Someone is trying to fix her up, and she has to admit that Nate Taggart is just her type. However, Nate is engaged to the daughter of the mayor and strictly off-limits ... Nate and Terri form an unlikely friendship while he throws himself into life at the lake. As Nate starts to hear rumors about Terri he's confused. Knowing how smart, beautiful and strong she is, he's determined to discover the source of the gossip. Terri doesn't want to revisit the past, but Nate won't stop until he discovers the truth – even if it might be more than either of them can handle.

Wrong Alibi by **Christina Dodd** (Trade Paperback – \$34). *Wrong Alibi Series*. Eighteen-year-old Evelyn Jones lands a job in small-town Alaska, working for a man in his isolated mountain home. But her bright hopes for the future are shattered when Donald White disappears, leaving her to face charges of theft, embezzlement – and a brutal double murder. Her protestations of innocence count for nothing. Convicted, she faces life in prison ... until fate sends her on the run. Evie's escape leaves her scarred and in hiding, isolated from her family, working under an alias at a wilderness camp. Bent on justice, intent on recovering her life, she searches for the killer who slaughters without remorse. At last, the day comes. Donald White has returned. Evie emerges from hiding; the fugitive becomes the hunter. But in her mind, she hears the whisper of other forces at work. Now Evelyn must untangle the threads of evidence before she's once again found with blood on her hands: the blood of her own family ...

No Holding Back by **Lori Foster** (Mass Market Paperback – \$20). *McKenzies of Ridge Trail Series*. Trucker Sterling (Star) Parson is no stranger to the challenges a woman faces, both in her industry and in life. But she can take care of herself. She's never needed – or wanted – a man around...until she meets Cade McKenzie. The take-charge bar owner sets off all kinds of alarm bells for Sterling, but he also sets her heart racing ... Cade's lived in Ridge Trail long enough to know trouble when he sees it, and the moment Sterling – Star – walks into his bar, he knows trouble's come to call. Secrets run deep in

the small town and Cade can tell Star's got as many as he does, leaving him itching to uncover every last one. But finding common ground will mean trusting one another, further feeding an intense attraction that's growing impossible to resist.

The Final Deception by **Heather Graham** (Mass Market Paperback – \$20). *New York Confidential Series*. It was one of psychologist Kieran Finnegan's most chilling cases: her assessment of a murderer known as the Fireman. There was no doubt that the man needed to be locked away. Now FBI agent Craig Frasier is called to a gruesome crime scene that matches the killer's methods, and news breaks that the Fireman has escaped prison ... Amid a citywide manhunt, Kieran and Craig need to untangle a web of deceit, privilege and greed. They suspect that those closest to the killer have been drawn into his evil, or else someone is using another man's madness and cruelty to disguise their crimes ... When their investigation brings the danger right to the doorstep of Finnegan's Pub, Kieran and Craig will have to be smarter and bolder than ever before, because this time it's personal, and they have everything to lose.

Under the Alaskan Ice by **Karen Harper** (Mass Market Paperback – \$20). *Alaska Wild Series*. The truth always surfaces. When a small bush plane smashes through the ice at Falls Lake Lodge, it's a chilling reminder of everything Megan Metzler has lost. Three years ago, Meg's pilot husband died in a similar crash, a tragedy Meg and her young son, Chip, have struggled to move on from. Still, Meg does everything she can to assist when Commander Bryce Saylor arrives to investigate, even as working alongside the handsome pilot stirs up painful memories – and an attraction that catches them both off guard ... Bryce knows time is of the essence as he plunges into the frigid water in search of clues. But when vital evidence is destroyed, it soon becomes clear this downed plane was no accident. With someone tracking them from the woods, Meg and Bryce must race to unravel a mystery as indomitable as the Alaskan wilderness, or they might be the next victims to crash and burn ...

After Sundown by **Linda Howard** and **Linda Jones** (Mass Market Paperback Release – \$20). Sela Gordon, shy owner of a Tennessee general store, prefers solitude. If anyone can chip away at her protective shell it's the mysterious, ex-military man who's been hiding for two years in the wilds of Cove Mountain. When he warns her that a catastrophic solar storm with the capability of taking down the power grids is approaching, Sela must come out of her shell and be the leader Wears Valley needs ... Living in self-imposed exile, Ben Jernigan has learned the hard way to look out for number one. With a top-notch security system, he's serious about keeping people at a distance. Yet he has to caution Sela about the impending threat – and now she's making it too easy for him to lower his guard ... As panic spreads, Sela and Ben discover that in the dark, cut off from the outside world, there's no more playing it safe – in life or in love.

The Persuasion by **Iris Johansen** (Mass Market Paperback Release – \$20). *Eve Duncan Series*. Forensic sculptor Eve Duncan and ex-Navy Seal Joe Quinn are about to give Seth Caleb their trust for

the most important duty of his life: keeping their daughter, Jane MacGuire, safe at any cost. Her talent as an artist has caught the attention of a brilliant psychopath with a violent past ... Seth, Jane's strongest ally and fiercest protector, is determined to keep her out of danger, but that becomes nearly impossible when Jane is forced to take matters into her own hands and confronts the madman who wants her for himself ... and wants Seth Caleb dead ... She's a wife, a mum, and as much as she adores her husband and sons, she wants something for herself – a sweet little bakery just off the waterfront. She knew changing the rules wouldn't be easy, but she never imagined she might have to choose between her marriage and her dreams ... Like the mainland on the horizon, Heather's goals seem beyond her grasp. Every time she manages to save any money, her mother has another crisis. Can Heather break free, or will she be trapped in this tiny life forever? Together over one summer these three cousins learn how the bonds of family and friendship can see us through even the most difficult of times.

Boone by **Emily March** (Mass Market Paperback – \$18). *Eternity Springs: McBrides of Texas Series*. With his smooth talk, rugged good looks, and deep pockets, native Texan Boone McBride appears to be a man who has it all. Few people know about the heartbreak behind his decision to leave home, family, and career for the isolation of a small town in the Colorado Rockies. Luckily, time in Eternity Springs has worked its healing magic upon his wounded soul, so when he meets troubled Hannah Dupree, Boone sees a chance to pay his good fortune forward. The last thing he anticipates is tumbling into love ... Tragedy has taken everything Hannah loves, and her will to keep going is failing. So when Boone strides into her life determined to save her, it's easier to go along with him than to resist. Soon she is drawn into the fabric of life in Eternity Springs, and as her spirit begins to heal, her strength returns, and she's able to go toe-to-toe with this big-hearted Texan. But just when love blooms and happiness is within their grasp, shadows from the past threaten. Worse yet, before Colonel Kegan can stand trial, he's found dead of a heart attack ... but Jessie knows it was murder. Forcing down her grief, she's determined to use her investigative skills and resources to clear her father's name. But going after the truth means Jessie soon finds herself in the crosshairs of a killer who wants that truth to stay buried with her father ... Protecting Jessie Kegan is a job bodyguard Brandon Garrett can't refuse. Jessie isn't just a client at Maximum Security – she's the sister of his best friend, Danny, killed in Afghanistan. With dangerous forces gunning for Jessie from every angle, keeping her safe will mean keeping her close and Bran finds their mutual attraction growing, though being Danny's sister puts Jessie out of bounds ... With their backs against the wall, Jessie and Bran will have to risk everything to expose her father's killer – before his legacy dies with his daughter.

Dance Away With Me by **Susan Elizabeth Phillips** (Mass Market Paperback Release – \$18). When life throws her one setback too many, midwife and young widow Tess Hartsong takes off for Runaway Mountain. In this small town high in the Tennessee mountains, surrounded by nature, she hopes to outrun her heartbreak and find the solace she needs to heal ... But instead of peace and quiet, she encounters an enigmatic artist with a craving for solitude, a fairy-tale sprite with too many secrets, a helpless infant, a passel of curious teens, and a town suspicious of outsiders, especially one as headstrong as Tess. Just as headstrong is Ian North, a difficult, gifted man with a tortured soul – a man who makes Tess question everything ... In running away to this new life, Tess wonders – Has she lost herself ... or has she found her future?

Our Italian Summer by **Jennifer Probst** (Trade Paperback – \$30). Workaholic Francesca is successful in all areas of her life except one: family. She struggles to make time for her relationship with her teenage daughter, Allegra, and the two have become practically strangers to each other. When Allegra hangs out with a new crowd and is arrested for drug possession, Francesca gives in to her mother's wish that they take one epic summer

vacation to trace their family roots in Italy. She just never expected to face a choice that might change the course of her life. ... Allegra wants to make her grandmother happy, but she hates the idea of forced time with her mother and vows to fight every step of the ridiculous tour, until a young man on the verge of priesthood begins to show her the power of acceptance, healing, and the heartbreaking complications of love ... Sophia knows her girls are in trouble. A summer filled with the possibility for change is what they all desperately need. Among the ruins of ancient Rome, the small churches of Assisi, and the rolling hills of Tuscany, Sophia hopes to show her girls that the bonds of family are everything, and to remind them that they can always lean on one another, before it's too late.

Reunited on Dragonfly Lane by **Annie Rains** (Mass Market Paperback – \$19). *Sweetwater Springs Series*. Boutique owner Sophie Daniels certainly isn't looking to adopt a dog the day veterinarian Chase Lewis convinces her to take in Comet. A rambunctious puppy with a broken leg may not be the best choice for a first-time pet owner. And house calls from the handsome doctor – her high school sweetheart who's just moved back to Sweetwater Springs – may not be the best choice for her heart either ... Chase has come home to help his nephew but finds that he's forgotten just how much he enjoys small-town life. However, sooner or later, he's going to have to face the past and his unresolved feelings for Sophie. Now that Comet needs both their help, Chase is going to let the four-legged matchmaker work his canine magic. Then Chase will prove to Sophie that first love is even better the second time around.

Say No More by **Karen Rose** (Mass Market Paperback Release – \$18). *Sacramento Series*. Seventeen years ago. That was the last time Mercy Callahan saw Ephraim Burton, the leader of the twisted Eden cult where she was raised. But even though she escaped the abuse and terror, they continue to haunt her ... When her brother Gideon discovers evidence of the cult's – and their victims' – whereabouts, Mercy goes to Sacramento to reconnect with him. There, she meets Gideon's closest friend – homicide detective Rafe Sokolov. From Rafe, she receives an offer she never knew she needed: to track down Ephraim and make him pay for everything ... But Ephraim, who had thought Mercy long dead, discovers she is in fact alive and that she is digging around for the cult's secrets. And now he'll do anything to take her back to Eden – dead or alive.

The Forever Girl by **Jill Shalvis** (Trade Paperback – \$32). *Wildstone Series*. When Maze returns to Wildstone for the wedding of her estranged bff and the sister of her heart, it's also a reunion of a once ragtag team of teenagers who had only each other until a tragedy tore them apart and scattered them wide ... Now as adults together again in the lake house, there are secrets and resentments mixed up in the childhood memories. Unexpectedly, they instantly fall back into their roles: Maze their reckless leader, Cat the den mother, Heather the beloved baby sister, and Walker, a man of mystery ... Life has changed them in immeasurable ways. Maze and Cat must decide if they can rebuild their friendship, and Maze discovers her attraction to Walker hasn't faded but has only grown stronger.

The Plot Is Murder by **V.M. Burns** (Mass Market Paperback Release – \$19). *Mystery Bookshop Series*. Samantha Washington has long dreamed of owning a mystery bookstore. And as she prepares for the grand opening, she's realizing another dream – penning a cozy mystery set in England between the wars. While Samantha hires employees and stocks her shelves, her imagination also gets to work as her heroine, Lady Penelope Marsh, long-overshadowed by her beautiful sister Daphne, refuses to lose the besotted Victor Carlston to her sibling's charms. When one of Daphne's suitors is murdered in a maze, Penelope steps in to solve the puzzle and win Victor ... Then, the unimaginable happens in real life. A shady realtor turns up dead in Samantha's backyard, and the police suspect her – she might know a thing or two about murder. Aided by her feisty grandmother and an ensemble of enthusiastic retirees, Samantha is determined to close the case before she opens her store. But will she live to conclude her own story when the killer has a revised ending in mind?

Lavender Blue Murder by **Laura Childs** (Mass Market Paperback Release – \$18). *Tea Shop Mystery Series*. Tea maven Theodosia Browning and her tea sommelier Drayton Connoley are guests at a bird hunt styled in the precise manner of an English shooting party. Which means elevenses, gun loaders, the drawing of pegs, fine looking bird dogs, and shooting costumes of tweed, herringbone, and suede ... But as gunshots explode like a riff of Black Cat firecrackers, another shot sounds too close for comfort. Intrigued but worried, Theodosia wanders into the neighbor's lavender field where she discovers their host, Reginald Doyle, bleeding to death ... His wife, Meredith, is beside herself with grief and begs Theodosia and Drayton to stay the night. But Theodosia awakens at 2:00A.M. to find smoke in her room and the house on fire. As the fire department screams in and the investigating sheriff returns, Meredith again pleads with Theodosia for help ... As Theodosia investigates, fingers are pointed, secrets are uncovered, Reginald's daughter-in-law goes missing presumed drowned, and Meredith is determined to find answers via a séance. All the while Theodosia worries if she's made a mistake in inviting a prime suspect to her upscale Lavender Lady Tea.

The Stranger by **Simon Conway** (Trade Paperback – \$30). ISIS can't control him. MI6 can't find him. But he's coming ... Things change quickly in the world of espionage and clandestine operations. Jude Lyon of MI6 remembers the captured terrorist bomb-maker. He watched him being flown off to Syria, back when Syria was 'friendly'. No-one expected him to survive interrogation there. Yet the man is alive and someone has broken him out of jail ... Bad news for the former foreign secretary who authorised his rendition. And Jude's boss Queen Bee who knew he wasn't a terrorist, but an innocent bystander. Now she calls Jude back from an enjoyable mission involving a Russian diplomat's wife ... He has a new job: close down this embarrassment. Fast. But embarrassment is only the beginning. Someone is using the former prisoner to front a new and unspeakably terrifying campaign. Someone not even ISIS can control ... He is like a rumour, a myth, a whisper on the desert wind. But he is real and he is coming for us ... He is the genius known only as ... The Stranger.

Prodigal Son by **Gregg Hurwitz** (Trade Paperback – \$30). *Orphan X Series*. As a boy, Evan Smoak was pulled out of a foster home and trained off-the-books as a government assassin, codenamed Orphan X. Forced into retirement, Evan Smoak gets an urgent request from someone he never expected – his mother. She needs his help protecting Andrew Duran, a man in the wrong place at the wrong time, with no safe place to hide. Running from a brutal assassination team, Duran's only hope lies with Evan. But when a hidden cabal catches on to what Evan is doing, everything he's fought for is on the line – including his own life.

The Gift by **Louise Jensen** (Mass Market Paperback Release – \$18). Jenna is given another shot at life when she receives a donor heart from a girl called Callie. Eternally grateful to Callie and her family, Jenna gets closer to them, but she soon discovers that Callie's perfect family is hiding some very dark secrets ... Tell Me Lies by **J.P. Pomare** (Trade Paperback – \$28). Psychologist Margot Scott has a picture-perfect life: a nice house in the suburbs, a husband, two children and a successful career ... On a warm spring morning Margot approaches one of her clients on a busy train platform. He is looking down at his phone, with his duffel bag in hand as the train approaches. That's when she slams into his back and he falls in front of the train ... Margot's clients all lie to her, but one lie cost her family and freedom.

Their only rivals in power are the White Flowers, who have fought the Scarlets for generations. And behind every move is their heir, Roma Montagov, Juliette's first love ... and first betrayal ... The Girl in the Green Silk Gown by **Seanan McGuire** (Trade Paperback – \$30). *Ghost Roads Series*. For Rose Marshall, death has become the only life she knows. She's been sweet sixteen for more than sixty years, hitchhiking her way along the highways and byways of America, sometimes seen as an avenging angel, sometimes a killer in her own right, but always Rose, the Phantom Prom Date, the Girl in the Green Silk Gown ... The man who killed her is still out there, thanks to a crossroads bargain that won't let him die, and he's looking for the one who got away. When Bobby Cross comes back into the picture, there's going to be hell to pay – possibly literally ... Rose has worked for decades to make a place for herself in the twilight. Can she defend it, when Bobby Cross comes to take her down? Can she

Yet Selenka's wolf is resolute: Ethan Night, broken Arrow and a man capable of obsessive devotion, is the mate it has chosen. Even if the mating bond is full of static and not quite as it should be. Because Selenka's new mate has a terrible secret, his mind surging with a power that is a creature of madness and death ...

Relying on a sisterhood of magic, a mysteriously faithful dog, and a second-rate sorcerer, Sidra defends herself using the village's greatest asset: its perfume. The earl might be charming and handsome, but she knows firsthand how dangerous attraction can be. The more determined Teresa is to discourage Arthur, the more entangled they get, and it's only a matter of time before her respect for him starts to feel a lot like love.

The Princess and the Rogue by **Kate Bateman** (Mass Market Paperback – \$18). *Bow Street Bachelors Series*. Bow Street agent Sebastien Wolff, Earl of Mowbray, doesn't believe in love – until a passionate kiss with a beautiful stranger in a brothel forces him to reconsider. When the mysterious woman is linked to an intrigue involving a missing Russian princess, however, Seb realizes her air of innocence was too good to be true ... Princess Anastasia Denisova has been hiding in London as plain 'Anna Brown'. With a dangerous traitor hot on her trail, her best option is to accept Wolff's offer of protection – and accommodation – at his gambling hell. But living in such close quarters fans the flames of their mutual attraction. If Anya's true identity is revealed, does their romance stand a chance?

The Worst Duke in the World by **Lisa Berne** (Mass Market Paperback – \$18). *Penhallow Dynasty Series*. Life's no bowl of cherries for Anthony Farr, the Duke of Radcliffe. Duty demands he remarry to provide a spare to go along with the heir – and eligible ladies keep trying to finagle him into a proposal. All he wants is to be a good father to his 8-year-old son, see the Duchess (his truly terrific pig) win first prize at the harvest fête, and stay single. Even if that makes him a Bad Duke. Maybe the Worst Duke in the World

Dancing with Danger by **Kerrigan Byrne** (Print-On-Demand Paperback – \$28). *Goode Girls Romance Series*. Mercy Goode is only truly good at one thing: finding mischief wherever she goes. Such as getting arrested at a murder scene with Raphael Sauvageau, a brutally handsome, ruthless smuggler with a

dangerous past and a dubious future. The silver-tongued devil doesn't deserve a lick of her confidence, but she has evidence that he's not the killer ... She can't deny that he's relentlessly wicked ... Raphael has no time for obsession. He's an empire to run, a murder to avenge, and a plan to save his brother that is likely a suicide mission. But this clever, infuriating bluestocking – who insists she's an amateur sleuth – keeps showing up where she doesn't belong. That's when Edward's aunt walks in, and thereafter announces Miss Georgiana Bly is the future Duchess of Thornfield ... Georgiana was content to be a spinster, spending her days reading and working to keep her family out of debt. But now her days are spent locked away with a growly duke, learning how to be the perfect duchess, and her nights spent fighting the undeniable attraction to a man who was never meant for her ... As their wedding day approaches, the attraction between them burns, but is it enough to melt the duke's chilly facade?

Hit Me With Your Best Scot by **Suzanne Enoch** (Mass Market Paperback – \$18). *Wild Wicked Highlanders Series*. Coll MacTaggart, Viscount Glendarril, is a big, brawny Highlander who doesn't like being told what to do – not even by his English mother who is determined to see her eldest son wed. However, when he comes to the rescue of an irresistibly beautiful woman, Coll discovers that he may have found his perfect match ... The challenge isn't that Persephone Jones is famous, wealthy, independent, and smarter than anyone he knows. The problem is that she isn't interested in marrying any man – especially not a hot-headed Scot – even if he is the only man who seems to understand who she really is even when she's not sure herself. When Coll learns that Persephone is actually a lady-in-hiding and someone is willing to kill her for what she stands to inherit ... Well, Coll has never been one to turn down a fight. When hearts are involved, nothing comes between a Highlander and his lady.

Ravish Me with Rubies by **Jane Feather** (Mass Market Paperback – \$19). *London Jewels Trilogy*. Petra Rutherford is certain she isn't the first dreamy-eyed girl that devilishly handsome Baron Granville of Ashton has loved and left behind. But when her brother's political ambitions place her before him once more, she's determined to give Guy Granville his own taste of torment. What better way to best a scoundrel than by luring his interest – before bringing things to an abrupt, embarrassing end? The only flaw in her gem of a plan is her still powerful attraction to the dazzling nemesis ... Guy Granville is disarmed by Petra's bold pursuit of him, so much so that he forgets he never intended to fall in love – much less entertain thoughts of marriage. Now, if

only the fiery Petra would stop sparring with him long enough to surrender to him completely – and allow him to convince her that his riches, his rubies, and his heart belong with her ...

Truly Madly Plaid by **Eliza Knight** (Mass Market Paperback – \$18). *Prince Charlie's Angels Series*. Annie MacPherson's world was torn apart when her family's castle was ravaged during the war. Determined to aid her countrymen, she braves the battlefield and finds gravely wounded Lieutenant Craig MacLean. Soon her heart belongs to the fierce warrior... As the English dragoons draw closer to Annie's makeshift hospital, Craig knows they have to escape together if they'll have any chance to survive. But when they come face-to-face with the enemy and Craig is imprisoned, Annie will have to risk everything to save the man she can't live without.

Highland Gladiator by **Kathryn Le Veque** (Mass Market Paperback – \$18). *Scots and Swords Series*. When Lor Careston's Highland village was attacked and burned, he felt helpless against the raiders who destroyed his home. Seeking revenge, but lacking the fighting skills he needs to execute his mission, he sets out to find the Ludus Caledonia – a mysterious fight guild that turns men into warriors ... Lor trains hard, proves himself in the ring, and earns a place with the very clan that decimated his home, having decided to set his plan for revenge in motion from inside the clan. But his plan didn't include Isabail Keith, a fiery lass who prefers swords to embroidery and isn't afraid to stand with the warriors of her clan. Lor thought the Keiths were his enemies, but when Isabail is threatened, he'll have to decide what he's willing to risk for the woman who has captured his heart and the clan that has become his home.

Her Wicked Marquess by **Stacy Reid** (Mass Market Paperback – \$18). *Sinful Wallflowers Series*. Miss Maryann Fitzwilliam is too witty and bookish for her own good. No gentleman of the ton will marry her, so her parents arrange for her to wed a man old enough to be her father. But Maryann is ready to use those wits to turn herself into a sinful wallflower ... When the scandal sheet reports a sighting of Nicolas St. Ives, the Marquess of Rothbury, climbing out the chamber windows of a house party, Maryann does the unthinkable. She anonymously claims that the bedchamber belonged to none other than Miss Fitzwilliam, tarnishing her own reputation – and chances of the dastardly union her family secured for her. Now she just needs to convince the marquess to

After escaping from the English soldiers who attacked her home and imprisoned her in a dungeon, Lady Elysande de Valance is grateful for the rugged Scots who are escorting her to safety in the Highlands. Even with danger dogging their every step, she hadn't expected to welcome the strong comforting embrace of their leader, Rory Buchanan. They say he's a healer, but she finds the heat of his touch does so much more ... Let his brothers get married – Rory is too busy tending to the sick to be bothered with wooing a bride. But when he is tasked with accompanying a family friend's "treasure" to the Highlands, he is surprised to learn the treasure is a beautiful woman on the run – and even more surprised to discover bruises hidden by her veil. Rory makes it his mission to tend to her injuries and protect her, but the thought of losing her makes him realize that perhaps it is his heart that is most in need of healing.

But after the episode airs, people start reaching out to Holly, and they all have one thing in common: they're terminally ill and want to leave their own missives behind for loved ones. Suddenly, Holly finds herself drawn back into a world she's worked tirelessly to leave behind – but one that leads her on another incredible journey.

The Lost and Found Bookshop by **Susan Wiggs** (Mass Market Paperback Release – \$20). In the wake of a tragedy, Natalie Harper inherits her mother's charming but financially strapped bookshop in San Francisco. She also becomes caretaker for her ailing grandfather Andrew ... But the gruff, deeply kind Andrew has begun displaying signs of decline. Natalie thinks it's best to move him to an assisted living facility. To pay for it, she plans to close the bookstore and sell the derelict but valuable building on historic Perdita Street, which is in need of constant fixing. There's only one problem – Grandpa Andrew owns the building and refuses to sell. Natalie adores her grandfather; she'll do whatever it takes to make his final years happy. Besides, she loves the store and its books provide solace for her grief ...
