Tell No Lies by **Allison Brennan** (Mass Market Paperback Release – \$22). *Quinn & Costa Thriller Series*. Something mysterious is killing the wildlife in the mountains south of Tucson. When a college intern turned activist sets out to collect evidence, she, too, ends up dead. Local law enforcement is slow to get involved. That's when the mobile FBI unit goes undercover to infiltrate the town and its copper refinery in search of leads ... Young detective Kara Quinn and loner FBI agent Matt Costa find themselves scouring the desolate landscape, which keeps revealing clues to something much darker – greed, child trafficking and more death. As the body count adds up, it's clear they have stumbled onto much more than they bargained for. Now they must figure out who is at the heart of this mayhem and stop them before more innocent lives are lost.

Savannah Cade's dreams are coming true. *THE* Claire Donovan, editor-in-chief of the most successful romance imprint in the country, has requested to see the manuscript Savannah's been secretly writing while working as editor herself – except at her publishing house, the

Despite his disdain for the trust-fund kids he sees coming and going from his town, Cooper realizes Mac isn't just another rich clone and falls for her. Hard. Some may have considered her a pampered princess, but Cate was a smart, scrappy fighter, and she managed to escape her abductors. Dillon Cooper was shocked to find the bloodied, exhausted girl huddled in his house – but when the teenager and his family heard her story they provided refuge, reuniting her with her loved ones ... Cate's ordeal, though, was far from over. First came the discovery of a shocking betrayal that would send someone she'd trusted to prison. Then there were years spent away in Ireland, peaceful and protected but with restlessness growing in her soul ... Finally, she would return to Los Angeles, gathering the courage to act again and get past the trauma that had derailed her life. What she didn't yet know was that two seeds had been planted that long-ago night – one of a great love, and one of a terrible vengeance ...

But her boss, legendary Seattle weatherwoman Torrance Hale, is too distracted by her tempestuous relationship with her ex-husband, the station's news director, to give Ari the mentorship she wants. Ari, who runs on sunshine and optimism, is at her wits' end. The only person who seems to understand how she feels is sweet but reserved sports reporter Russell Barringer ... In the aftermath of a disastrous holiday party, Ari and Russell decide to team up to solve their bosses' relationship issues. under pressure, and trained in weapons of all types. But Gabriela’s latest job isn’t for some billionaire, it’s for her own family, whose home is going to be wiped off the map if they can’t come up with a lot of money fast ... Inspired by an old family legend, Gabriela sets off for the jungles of Peru in pursuit of the *Ring of Solomon* and the lost treasure of Lima. But this job comes with a huge problem attached to it – Gabriela’s ex-husband, Rafer. It’s Rafer who has the map that possibly points the way to the treasure, and he’s not about to let Gabriela find it without him ... Having just survived an attack on his life and the complete devastation of his base of operations, as well as his complicated (and deepening) relationship with his neighbor Mia Hall, Evan isn’t interested in taking on a new mission. But one finds him anyway ... Aragon Urrea is a kingpin of a major drug-dealing operation in South Texas. He’s also the patron of the local area – supplying employment in legitimate operations, providing help to the helpless, rough justice to the downtrodden, and a future to a people normally with little hope. He’s complicated – a not completely good man, who does bad things for often good reasons. However, for all his money and power, he is helpless when one of the most vicious cartels kidnaps his eighteen year old daughter, spiriting her away into their armored headquarters in Mexico. With no other way to rescue his daughter, he turns to *The Nowhere Man* ... Now not only must Evan figure out how to get into the impregnable fortress of a paranoid cartel leader, but he must also decide if he should help a very bad man – no matter how just the cause.

Molly Gray is not like everyone else. She struggles with social skills and misinterprets the intentions of others. Her gran used to interpret the world for her, codifying it into simple rules that Molly could live by ... Since Gran died a few months ago, twenty-five-year-old Molly has had to navigate life's complexities by herself. No matter – she throws herself with gusto into her work as a hotel maid. Her unique character, along with her obsessive love of cleaning and proper etiquette, make her an ideal fit for the job. She delights in donning her crisp uniform each morning, stocking her cart with miniature soaps and bottles, and returning guest rooms at the Regency Grand Hotel to a state of perfection ... But Molly's orderly life is turned on its head the day she enters the suite of the infamous and wealthy Charles Black, only to find it in a state of disarray and Mr. Black himself dead in his bed. Before she knows what's happening, Molly's unusual demeanor has the police targeting her as their lead suspect. She quickly finds herself caught in a web of deception, one she has no idea how to untangle. Fortunately for Molly, friends she never knew she had unite with her in a search for clues to what really happened to Mr. Black – but will they be able to find the real killer before it's too late?

It's a quiet, snowy morning at *The Cracked Spine* bookshop, when bookseller Delaney Nichols receives a mysterious visitor, a messenger. He presents her with a perplexing note: an invitation to a meeting with eccentric socialite Shelagh O'Conner, who requests Delaney's participation in an exclusive treasure hunt. Delaney is intrigued, but also cautious: Shelagh, while charming in person, has a

reputation for her hijinks as a wealthy young woman in the '70s. She was even suspected of the murder of a former boyfriend, though ultimately cleared of all charges ... But Delaney is enticed by the grand prize at the end of the treasure hunt: a highly valuable first edition copy of *The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde*, by Robert Louis Stevenson. The winner is also to receive the contents of Shelagh's vast library, and all participants will earn a large sum of cash ... The night after the first meeting of the treasure hunters, however, several homes in Edinburgh are robbed in a manner reminiscent of Shelagh's old tricks. And when a man connected to Shelagh is killed, suspicion builds. Except Shelagh herself has disappeared from her home, seemingly kidnapped by the villain ... Terror mounts throughout the city as Delaney attempts to solve the mystery, while trying to evade the killer's clutches. Now that critical psychic network is dying, threatening to collapse and kill the entire Psy race with it ...
